#### CANINE COMMUNICATION

Dogs speak a language based on subtle body language cues. Learning to read and understand this language is imperative for any canine professional. This course will teach you how to read the signs of stress, aggression, fear and much more in a dog. Knowing this language can help a dog walker prevent dog attacks, dog fights, keep themselves and the pets safe and help them communicate with dogs better.

#### **DOG BREEDS**

The course will discuss in depth the internationally recognised breed groups and the breed characteristics that influence training and behaviour in a dog. It will discuss the impact of a breed on the training, walking and handling of the dog.

It will include information on how to adapt training to the different breeds and why. It will discuss original breeding purposes and how they affect the training of the dog for leash walking.

- What role does a dog's breed play in leash walking?
- Why it is important for a dog walker to understand the origins of dog breeds?
- How can we work with a dog's breed in training rather than forcing it to conform to one set of rules?
- What role does a dog's breed play in mental stimulation and the games we play with dogs?
- How to understand a breed and the genetics behind it







#### **CANINE BEHAVIOUR**

As a dog walker, you will often be confronted with pets who display behaviour issues or pet parents who want answers to their problems. A sturdy knowledge of canine behaviour can help a dog walker upscale their service, give educated advice and help pet parents and dogs alike. The topics will include:

- Toilet training of puppies and adult dogs a much in demand skill for dog walkers
- Boredom in dogs
- Fussy eating dogs
- Barking in dogs
- Hyperactive dogs
- Saying hello to a dog correctly how not to get bitten
- Exercising teenage dogs
- Fearful dogs

#### **DOG TO DOG ISSUES**

Dog walkers often will walk two or more dogs together or need to handle multiple dogs simultaneously. Dog walkers hence need to learn the following topics:

#### **CANINE NUTRITION**

One of the most asked queries by pet parents is on canine nutrition. This course will cover...

- Can a dog eat the same food every day?
- Does diet play a role in dog behaviour?

#### **DOG PLAY, GAMES AND TOYS**

The life of a dog walker is to exercise a dog. Exercise is not just about walks or physical exercise; mental exercise is just as important. There are days a dog maybe unwell, injured or the weather may not be conducive for a walk. A trained dog walker should have knowledge about how to exercise a dog in general. From simple games to complex ones, all will be taught. Games are a great way to keep a bored dog out of trouble and to exercise the mind of an active breed.

- How to play with a dog
- Safe games to play and games that should be avoided
- Why rough play does more harm than good

In 2015, Shirin was awarded the International Commendation for Trainer of the Year award by the Kennel Club of England's KCAI scheme at the Cruft's Dog Show in England.

In 2016, Shirin was invited to lecture at the Association of Professional Pet Dog Trainers (APDT) conference in Las Vegas. She is the first Indian to have been invited by this prestigious body to present at the conference.

In 2017, Shirin was invited to present at TEDx Gitam University and in 2019 at TEDx Dharavi.

In 2018, Shirin was awarded The First Ladies award and felicitated for being a pioneer in her field by The President of India at the Rashtrapati Bhavan.

Over the past 25 years, Shirin Merchant has trained over one thousand dog lovers who are pursuing successful careers in the field of dog training and behaviour around the world. Her students rank as some of the top trainers in India.
